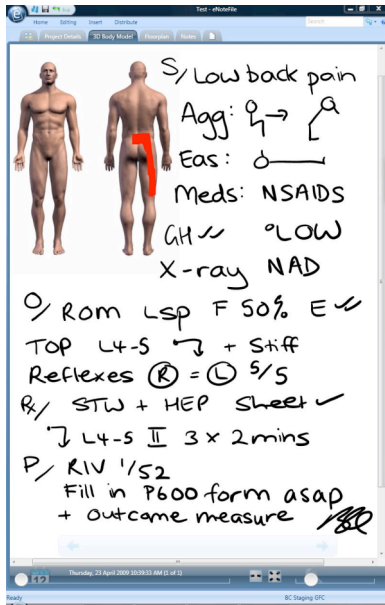


Image 1: eNoteFile – medical example

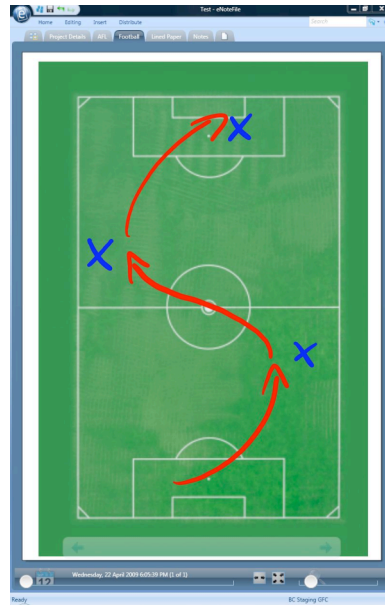


Image 2: eNoteFile – sport example
