

FOUR STEP DATA BREACH PLAN



1. CONTAIN

When faced with a breach, take immediate steps to control any further damage or loss of information. **Tip:** Having a response plan in place will greatly reduce the time it takes to contain the security situation.

2. ASSESS


You have 30 days to determine if a breach will cause serious harm to any individuals with compromised information. We recommend having an assessment process ready to decide whether to take remedial action and reduce harm or recover information then move to **Review**, or if you need to **Notify**.

3. NOTIFY

If the harm is serious then you must notify the Privacy Commissioner and affected individuals. This includes filling in a form, creating a statement about the data breach and recommending what steps the affected individual should take in response to the breach. **Fact:** 60% of Australian businesses experienced a cyber-attack in the last year*.

4. REVIEW

Keep records of the incident and take action to prevent future breaches including developing prevention plans, conducting audits, and training. At this point, if you have notified, then determine whether further notifications (ASIC, ATO) need to happen. **Tip:** Document everything.
